



## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The following rules for safe range usage have been enacted by the Osseo Gun Club & Pro Shop and must be strictly adhered to by all persons using the facilities:

- **Do:**

- Use NRA safe firearms handling rules and common firing line courtesies and discipline will be practiced and tutored on all ranges at all times
- Handle and treat all firearms as if they were loaded. Keep your finger off of the trigger until ready to shoot. Keep all firearms pointed downrange at all times.
- Make sure the angle of your shooting is so that your round does not impact the ceiling, floor or walls.
- Wear eye and ear protection at all times while on the range.
- Keep all firearms in your assigned stall and pointed down range at all times.
- Place all bags, guns and gear taken into the bays to your side in your respective lane.
- Disclose all types of firearms and ammunition taken out to the range.
- Sweep brass forward and throw away all trash in receptacles behind you when finished.

- **Do Not:**

- Do not take any food or drink on the range for health and safety reasons.
- Do not pull out a firearm in the retail area without permission and under the close supervision of an employee.
- If there is an issue with any firearms on the range please leave the firearm in your shooting stall and ask one of our range officers for assistance.
- Do not remove firearms from the shooting position unless they are unloaded and in a case.
- Do not clean or disassemble firearms out on the range or retail area. We are not responsible for lost parts.



## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Do not fire any steel shot, BB's, steel core, military surplus, tracer, ammunition.
- Do not fire at running target more than 2 lanes on each side of you except in competitions.
- Do not switch firearms from lane to lane, move shooters not firearms.
- Do not allow your children under the age of 18 out of your sight the minimum age for shooters is 11 years old.
- Do not draw from holster on the range except in tactical bay under supervision.
- No rapid fire, which means 1 shot every 2 seconds with the exception of double taps.
- No double taps allowed in the rifle bay.
- Do not use any I Pods, phones, or cameras while out on the range for safety reasons. Do not create any type of distraction that can cause a safety issue.
- No More than two guns on firing line at any one time.
- Only two people( Adults) per standard stall- 3 People on wide lanes
- **Fine Print:**
  - Any damage to the range equipment will be assessed and a charge is applied to the bill prior to check out and may be prosecuted for vandalism if deemed appropriate..
  - If there is a problem on the range with a firearm, please lay the firearm down pointed downrange and get a range officer.
  - All range officers have the right to deny range accesses if any of the range rules are violated resulting in an unsafe act.
  - For safety reasons, all ammunition will be inspected before entering the range. NO Tracers, aluminum or chrome cased or steel core allowed. Upon check in please present all of your ammunition for inspection.
  - Some calibers may not be shot on range – 50 cal and 338 rifle are not allowed along with shotgun loads .
  - All shooter are required to be 21 years or older unless with an adult.
